A. Call to Order via ZOOM: The regular monthly Board Meeting of the Otter Rock Water District Board was held on November 9, 2021 via ZOOM. The meeting convened at 6:02 pm with Commissioner Hall presiding.

C) Consent Agenda:

Board review of meeting summary for the October meeting resulted with no changes needed.

D) Reports, updates and announcements

- **a. Water Operator's Report** Robert Trotter of Hiland Water presented a report on current water conditions. October water tests resulted in no positives of any contaminates. Spring flow is fair and we are still running with spring #1 & 2 only. Hiland is bringing on a new staff member for the Newport area.
 - 1. Chlorination project update The chlorination system is not functioning well due to low flow. Last tests for residual resulted in no detectable amount anywhere in the system. They have ordered additional equipment to inject a constant small amount of chlorine into the system. Silas Olsen is writing a letter to seek final approval from the state.
 - 2. Meter installations update Hiland is still working on assessment for additional meter installs.

Other - The 3rd street new service install has been completed except for the meter box..

b. Office/Treasurer's Report

Commissioner Cutler presented a report of current finances and answered questions. The Profit & Loss report needs some revisions which will be done in the next few weeks. Commissioner Elliker contacted our payroll provider Paychex who files all tax payments and tax forms and they should be taking care of that.
